- Entry forms for the NZ Championships are available on the marching website events page www.marching.co.nz/events Closing date for entries is 31st January 2019. When entry forms are forwarded to the Association please check that all details are completed on the form and that all members are registered and remember to send a copy to the Host Association, Marching Canterbury. You are also required to verify that the team has complied with
 - NZC3-1a/b all members are registered, the Team has competed in the phases they are entering in at least two days of championships and/or competition in their association, have competed in their own Island Championships
 - RAC5-1/2 they have been granted permission to travel by the Association and can satisfy the Association that the team has sufficient funds in order to meet such commitments.
- **Conviction Check Policy** reminder to follow up with those members still to provide a copy of their report for sighting by the Membership Privacy Officer. All Association Committee and Team Management Officials are required as per the MNZ Policy to provide a Conviction Check Report with their registration. Please check that Team Management on entry forms for the NZ Championships have provided the documentation and if not an urgent reminder to get it processed prior to the NZ Championships. There are no valid excuses for not having completed it now, they have had 6 months.
- **NZ Championships** planning is well underway by Marching Canterbury and a very BIG THANK YOU to them for hosting this prestigious event on our marching calendar. The Championships will be held indoors at the Horncastle Arena, Christchurch and information/updates will be forwarded and will on the MNZ website.
- **Island Championships** were successfully hosted by Marching Waikato and Marching Canterbury, and sincere thanks for providing a great experience for the participants and the spectators. Many thanks for the prompt circulation of the results enabling social media to be updated for those members not able to attend.
