

COMPETITIVE REQUIREMENTS SENIOR GRADE

No. of Marchers: Review & Inspection / Technical Drill: 7 to 10
Display: 7 – 14

Any less or more than the specified number of marchers competing in the Review & Inspection/Technical Drill/Display will result in the team deeming themselves non-competitive in that phase.

Emphasis: 50% Technical Drill and 50% Display – to be reflected in Judging System, Awards and Recognition

Leader: Out front, not individually judged.

Format: Technical Drill to consist of a Review & Inspection, Compliments, Quickstep, Drills, 9-11 Movements, March Off.

Display of 3 minutes to 3 minutes 45 seconds duration with requirements as set out in the Display Section of the Drills & Routines Criteria. For compliance purposes the Display must be performed with at least the minimum time of 3 minutes and not more than the maximum time of 3 minutes 45 seconds.”

A penalty of one point per second under or over the minimum or maximum time set will be applied.

A repeat of the Quickstep/Compliments/Movements phase will not fulfil the requirements of the display performance criteria and therefore will incur a **RAC11.1** penalty.

Phases: May enter Technical Drill or Display, or both.

Judging: Five Technical Drill and two Display judges.

Uniforms: As per requirements set out in the Uniform Section of the Policy & Operations Manual (Technical).

Gala March: (Retired)

No. of Marchers: 6–12 (Maximum on the Performance Area at any one time – 8)

Emphasis: Competitive entertainment befitting a Gala occasion.

Format: Performance area, preferably elevated, of 8m (frontage) x 6m (depth). Teams own devised drills and music composition with a few set drills as outlined in the Drills and Routines. Time of 2m 30s to 3m.

Uniforms: Befitting a Gala occasion. Dignity of Sport maintained by meeting modesty and decency standards.
