

Start: By the Centre Quick March

All Members	Move to the Position of Stand at Ease
	Move to the Position of Attention Pause two beats
Leader & No. 1	March fifteen paces, review halt, pause four beats
No. 2	March thirteen paces, review halt, pause six beats,
No. 3	March eleven paces, review halt, pause eight beats
No. 4	March eleven paces, review halt, pause eight beats
No. 5	March nine paces, review halt, pause ten beats
No. 6	March seven paces, review halt, pause twelve beats
No. 7	March seven paces, review halt, pause twelve beats
No. 8	March five paces, review halt, pause fourteen beats
No. 9	March three paces, review halt, pause sixteen beats
All Members	Left turn
Nos. 1/4/7	March four paces, review halt, pause one beat
Leader & Nos. 2/5/8	Pause two beats, march two paces, review halt, pause one beat (Leader's disc will be judged at this point)
Nos. 3/6/9	Pause six beats
Leader	Pause twenty-four beats
Nos. 1/2/3	Turn head to the right, pause one beat, then during the next
	four beats adjust spacing and dressing, turn head to the front,
	pause one beat, pause sixteen beats.
Nos. 4/5/6	Pause eight beats, turn head to the right, pause one beat, then
	during the next four beats adjust spacing and dressing, turn
	head to the front, pause one beat, pause eight beats.
Nos. 7/8/9	Pause sixteen beats, turn head to the right, pause one beat,
	then during the next four beats adjust spacing and dressing,
	turn head to the front, pause one beat
All Members	Pause eight beats, saluting on beat three and concluding on
	beat six, stand fast
All Members	The team will then stand fast until the Leader is directed
	by the Technical A Judge to form into Team Formation.
	Londow Loft hum and voncein on the disc
	Leader: Left turn and remain on the disc
	With No. 1 in front, followed by Nos. 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9 form a single line and march directly to form up behind
	the Leader in team formation. Following the
	Leaders command the team may quickly and
	efficiently interchange members in readiness to
	commence the Q/C/M, then right turn.
	(Note: The R&I Finish Disc is also the Q/C/M Assembly disc)
